

<u>Federal Regulation of Coke Ovens:</u> <u>Battery NESHAP (Charging, Leaks, and Bypass Stacks)</u> (part 63, subpart L)

For this NESHAP, there are two sets of standards. The first are the standards for MACT track facilities. The second are the standards for LAER track facilities, which elected to adopt more stringent requirements in earlier years, in return for a postponement of additional regulation until January 1, 2020.

By 2010, the standards for each track converged, becoming uniform throughout the industrial sector.
