- 1. The Department's Enforcement Order (#190202) is temporarily stayed. This temporary stay shall remain in effect through March 11, 2019.

the temporary stay will remain in effect until there is a decision on U.S. Steel's Petition for Stay.

4. A telephonic status conference is scheduled for March 11, 2019 at 2 p.m. If the parties have not reached a resolution of the matters at issue in U.S. Steel's Petition for Stay by this time, the undersigned will consider whether to extend the temporary stay until there is a decision on U.S. Steel's Petition for Stay.

5. A hearing on Appellant's Petition for Stay is scheduled for March 26, 2019 beginning at 9:30 a.m.
